# AGGIELAND HUMANE SOCIETY AWARDED \$15,470 GRANT

Aggieland Humane Society has been awarded a Texas Animal Friendly Grant totaling \$15,470! By purchasing an Animal Friendly License Plate, residents have enabled AgHS to create the "Aggieland Sterilization Campaign" for spaying and neutering Pit Bulls and Chows in five counties; Brazos, Burleson, Grimes, Madison, and Robertson. Veterinarians will perform subsidized spay/neuter surgeries for Pit Bulls and Chows.

Spaying and neutering your pet is an important part of being a responsible pet owner. Unwanted litters create unnecessary stress on the pet, pet owner, and shelter. Our



hope is that the "Aggieland Sterilization Campaign" will reduce the number of Pit Bulls and Chows in animal shelters in our region and promote spay/neuter education.




She brings joy and laughter to everyone she meets. Cotah is my world.

Betty West started her volunteering journey almost two years ago, hoping to find peace after a tough loss.

"My long-time friend, a Corgi, passed away. I had been grieving for a while. I decided to volunteer at Aggieland Humane (Society), so I could still be around dogs," she said.

Once at Aggieland Humane, Betty began working with dogs that needed to learn manners. The training has reaped benefits; dogs that needed a little more attention have found loving homes.

"My passion is seeing the dogs that I work with get adopted, especially those that have stayed in our facility a long time."

The biggest lesson she has learned is that every animal that comes into the shelter is looking for a little love from humans.

"Some pit bulls have never experienced love. I see them cowering, with their tails down. After I spend a little time with them, walk them, and talk to them softly, they become a sweet animal. It is rewarding when I find them wagging their

# GIVING TO SAVE

## Remember Us in Your Will

Many people who have supported charities with gifts during their lifetime also provide future gifts for their favorite charity or charities by including them in their Will. There are several options available that will allow you to ensure that your family and other loved ones are provided for and still include charity in your planning. If you are completing or updating your estate documents and would like to consider Aggieland Humane Society in your Will, the following information may be helpful.

Below, are some common types of bequests and samples of how bequests may be worded in your Will or Trust. We always recommend you seek counsel from an estate attorney when preparing or updating your documents.

#### **General Bequest:**

A general bequest provides that a specific amount of money, a percentage of your estate or a certain piece of property is given to charity at the time of your death.

#### Percentage:

I give, devise and bequest \_\_\_\_\_ % of my estate, after taxes and debts have been satisfied to Aggieland Humane Society, a qualified 501(c)(3) charitable organization located in Bryan, TX,

#### **Specific Amount or Asset:**

I give, devise and bequest the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ (or a description of the specific asset) to Aggieland Humane Society, a qualified 501(c)(3) charitable organization located in Bryan, TX,

#### **Residuary Bequest:**

A residuary bequest designates that after you have provided for your family and other loved ones the remainder, or balance, of your estate goes to a charity or charities.

All the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, I give to Aggieland Humane Society, a qualified 501(c)(3) charitable organization located in Bryan, TX,

#### **Contingent Bequest:**

A contingent bequest allows you to leave apportion of your estate to a particular charity if your named beneficiaries do not survive you.

In the event my spouse and all of my children should die prior to the distribution of my estate without leaving descendants surviving such event, then, and in that event, the undistributed corpus of my estate shall be distributed to Aggieland Humane Society, a qualified 501(c)(3) charitable organization located in Bryan, TX,

Many charities, including Aggieland Humane Society, like to keep a record of individuals who have included them in their Will, so they can keep these individuals updated on important issues and events within the organization. The following language is provided for your convenience if you would like to notify the charities you have included in your Will.

#### Dear Sir or Madame

I/we wanted to inform you that I/we have included Aggieland Humane Society in my/our estate planning as a beneficiary under my/our Will(s). We are pleased to be able to provide for you in this way.
