1 Dachshund & 200 Kittens Meet a unique foster family saving lives

Annually, more than one thousand cats and kittens find themselves at Aggieland Humane searching for their second chance at forever families.

Some of these kittens are motherless and need bottle-feeding to survive. Sometimes, a cat is injured and needs a lifesaving procedure. All pets arrive with different needs, but they have one thing in common - no place to call home. **Enter Kaitlin Raley and her best friend Sarah, a dachshund who has a knack for helping her feline friends.**

YOU are the hero. Fosters and donors provide the necessary lifesaving resources and safe places for these pets to grow and heal.

Over seven years ago, Kaitlin, Aggieland Humane Administrative Coordinator, was **inspired to foster when she saw the "heartbreaking number of kittens"** needing foster homes. After raising her first litter, **she knew this was her calling; unbeknownst to Kaitlin, it was her rescue dog Sarah's calling too!**

Kaitlin and Sarah have fostered nearly 200 pets to date! We asked Kaitlin if any pets had made an impact on her and while she said, "so many" she recalled one pet in particular.

"I recently fostered a kitten named Shorty after leg amputation surgery. Sarah comforted Shorty during the initial recovery, but the moment Shorty was ready to play, Sarah was too. They were constantly sliding across the house - one giant blur of dog, kitten, and toys."



According to Kaitlin, **this dynamic duo is on a mission to save as many pets as possible.** And when asked ,she said you should go for it too! "Through the years, the need for fosters and funds has only grown!"

When my mom first said we would be "fostering" little tiny baby kitties, I was a little concerned. I am a dog! I didn't know anything about raising kittens.

But let me tell you, I had nothing to worry about. Nothing at all!

Kittens are awesome. They cuddle with you, they let you lick their little faces... and sometimes they even play with you.

One time we fostered a kitten named Lilo. Lilo was so much fun. Mom went to work on our first day together, and Lilo busted out of her kennel to hang out with me! We were best friends after that. I taught her how to help mom in the garden (I dug holes, Lilo sat in a flower pot) and how to burrow under the covers in mom's bed at night. We took lots of great naps together while mom was at work. And Lilo always brought her toys to me when she wanted to play.

Sometimes I miss Lilo, but then I remember I trained her to be a good kitten. And now she's living the best life ever with her new family! I am one proud pup.

Creme Brulee


